Jacinta Garcia Hernandez was born on September 11, 1961. She is a native of San Agustin Loxicha, Pochutla, Oaxaca, Mexico. She had polio when she was 8 years old, so she uses a wheelchair. In March 1990 she came to Casa Hogar Benito Juarez, located in San Agustin de las Juntas, Oaxaca, Mexico. For 26 years she has volunteered full time performing different duties in Casa Hogar.

Currently, she is 55 years old and has **AORTIC VALVULAR HEART** disease with post polio syndrome; and needs a valve implant operation to place a valve in her heart.

The expenses of the operation and hospitalization are \$ 8,170.00 (eight thousand, one hundred and seventy dollars)
