As the school year progresses, the needs continue. To get the building of the necessary classrooms started, a courageous group from Cannon Community Church in Cannon Falls, MN came to build our first classroom. A few of the challenges they encountered were...metric conversions on the measurements and purchasing of materials... sharing their living space with 120 other people (we helped host a lady pastor's conference with the church at the same time they



were here, and guest housing was packed out!)...drinking oatmeal water and eating grasshoppers....dealing with Moctezuma and his revenge... having the resident kitchen mice do a corporate takeover (good thing we are dealing with Vikings!), and adjusting to living at an altitude of 1 mile above sea-level. This was an amazingly flexible and hardworking group who worked diligently for months in advance to solvent the construction costs. THANK YOU for all your hard work!! 90% of the first classroom is done...2 more are needed urgently...come on down...we need ALL the help we can get!!! A host of awesome adventures awaits you..?!!
